
Set in over 275 acres of stunning English countryside and boasting exquisite décor, Stock Brook Manor is an idyllic setting for a wedding.

Essex Country Council granted approval for Stock Brook Manor to be used as a venue for the solemnization of marriages, under the 1949 and 1994 Marriage Acts on the 1st day of October 1999.

To arrange a ceremony at it is necessary to initially make a provisional booking with Stock Brook Manor for the date required, which will be held for seven days. Within this period the bride and groom should then telephone the Central Registration Office on 03456 037632 for advice and to check availability and the current rates.

The Ballroom has all the facilities and elegant refinements necessary for a grand wedding.


It boasts amazing panoramic views overlooking 275 acres of breathtaking grounds and landscaped, carefully managed, rolling lawns and gardens.



HOW TO FIND US



STOCK BROOK THE COUNTRY CLUB

From M25 (Clockwise)

Take Junction 28 A12 – Follow signs towards Chelmsford.

From A12

Exit Junction 16 B1007, Signposted Galleywood & Billericay, follow B1007 towards Billericay through the village of Stock at the roundabout turn right into Queens Park Avenue, approx 500 yards entrance is on the right.

From M25 (Anti-Clockwise)

Take Junction 29 A127 – follow signs to Basildon/Southend then exit at Basildon/Billericay junction follow signs to Billericay then go through High Street following signs to Chelmsford. Over mini roundabout by Rail Station, over next mini roundabout and at the next roundabout turn left into Queens Park Avenue. Approx 500 yards entrance is on the right. If using a satellite navigation system please use CM12 OFD.
